OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 09-118 (Special Election – Senate District 28)

WHEREAS, Section 100.101(2), Florida Statutes, provides that a vacancy in the office of state Senate shall be filled by special election; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 114.01(1)(d), Florida Statutes, a vacancy now exists in the state Senate due to the resignation of Senator Ken Pruitt, Senate District 28; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Section 100.141, Florida Statutes, the Governor is obligated, after consulting with the Secretary of State, to issue an order declaring the date the special election shall be held;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, CHARLIE CRIST, as Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to take care that the laws be faithfully executed, and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby promulgate the following Executive Order, to take immediate effect:

Section 1.

A special election shall be held in Senate District 28 to fill the vacancy in the state Senate.

Section 2.

A special primary election shall be held on June 30, 2009.

Section 3.

A special general election shall be held on August 4, 2009, to select the state Senator for Senate District 28.
